

Doll Bunting for 12" - 14" doll

Supplies Needed:

| | |
|---|-----------|
| Flannel (for front) | 22" x 18" |
| Coordinating cotton fabric (for lining) | 22" x 18" |
| Lightweight batting | 22" x 18" |
| ¼" – ½" grosgrain ribbon | 1 yard |
| Gathered eyelet lace | 1 yard |
| Double-faced satin ribbon | ½ yard |

Seam allowances are ½" for entire project.



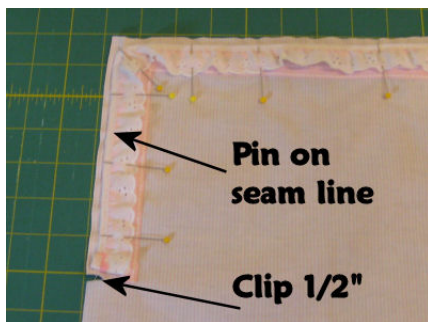
Measure and mark 7" down on the short sides of both flannel and cotton fabrics.

Set the flannel aside.

On right side of cotton fabric, use a water-soluble marker to mark 1" across the top and down 7" on each side.

This mark creates a placement line for the center of the grosgrain ribbon.

Stitch both sides of the grosgrain ribbon, securing the ends and mitering corners at the top.



Clip cotton fabric ½" into seam allowance at 7" mark.

Fold eyelet up ½" at each end.

Place eyelet lace wrong side down on seam line and pin in place.

Baste on seam line.

Fold lining fabric in half with right sides together.

Stitch 3" seam from bottom towards clip.

Stitch 3" seam from clip towards bottom.

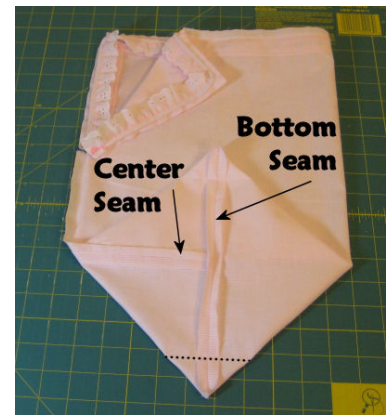
This leaves an opening for turning the lining after it is sewn to the front.

Press seams open.

With right sides together, fold lining fabric so center seam and opening are in the middle.

Stitch ½" seam across the bottom. Press open.

Fold lining fabric with bottom seam even with side folds.
 Measure 1 ¼” from point.
 Mark stitch line across the point.
 Stitch seam across marked line.
 Turn and repeat for other point.
 This seam creates a square bottom on lining of the bunting.



Place batting under flannel with flannel right side up.
 Baste together ¼” around all sides.

(Refer to photos of cotton lining to prepare flannel and batting.)

Clip ½” to the mark on each side of the flannel and batting.
 Fold batting and flannel in half with right sides together.
 Stitch ½” seam from bottom to clip. Do not leave an opening in this seam.
 Finger press open.
 With right sides together, fold batting and flannel so center seam is in the middle.
 Stitch ½” seam across the bottom. Finger press open.
 Fold batting and flannel with bottom seam even with side folds.
 Measure 1 ¼” from point.
 Mark stitch line across the point.
 Stitch seam across marked line.
 Turn and repeat for other point.
 This seam creates a square bottom on the front of the bunting.

Turn lining right side out.
 Slip inside front of bunting, matching center seams and corners.
 Using the basting seam which attached the eyelet to the lining as a guide, stitch from clips to corners and across the top.
 Clip corners.
 Turn through opening in lining.
 Stitch opening closed by hand or machine.



Holding the eyelet out of the way, stitch across the center seam. Backstitch to hold in place.

Stitch the center of the double faced satin ribbon over this seam.

Tie a bow and stitch in place so it won't untie.
